How Long Do I Sponsor My Child?

When you sponsor a child, you sign up for a child's journey through school. God Cares School educates and discipless students as young as three years and as old as university or trade school age. You can be part of that journey for as long as you feel led. Rest assured, once a child is part of our sponsorship program, we are committed to them through their entire school process, and if a sponsor is no longer able to support their child, we will trust God for a new sponsor.

Buyamba has now seen 3,000 children through our program. We believe each child is a gift that God has given to us to care for during the time we have them. His plan may move a child to a different village after a year, or we may see

them one day graduate from God Cares High School into an engineering program at a university or study for a certificate in hotel and hospitality at a trade school. Each child has hopes and dreams, and with a current count of 1,800 children, that is a lot of dreamers! One of the things a sponsored child often says in their letters to their sponsors is, **"Thank you for making my future bright!"**



This is precisely what sponsorship does. It's an honor to serve another life in an impactful way and lead a child to hold hands with the Lord while learning to read and write. **However long you sponsor a child, their life will be impacted forever.**
