You will be welcomed with open arms!

There are many questions that you will have in the coming months about how to prepare, what to bring and how to plan. We have included many ideas to help you along. Please read through the Mission Travel Team Information, and complete the forms included in this packet at your earliest convenience.

Travel dates, lodging and projects all need to be approved by the Buyamba Office. Please contact me directly when you have a general idea of when you may want to travel and we will check the Team Trip Calendar to secure your date. Due to the complexity of serving a team well in Uganda, it is our hopes to spread the trips out so there is little to know overlap if possible.

God Cares School is a Christian School and therefore we ask that mission trips be Christ centered and all sharing be from a biblical perspective. This will be a Christian School environment and only that worldview is accepted here as to not confuse the students. We are relying on you, the team leader to know your people. Please use the application process in your screening and if available, it would be appropriate to run some kind of background check.

Please contact me when you are ready to begin this process and we will begin our journey together. The Dongo family is the authority at God Cares School and will take the lead as your guide in Uganda. Enclosed you will find a lot of information, along with forms that must be filled out and returned to our office before your trip.

We are praying for you! God bless you and your efforts to serve these amazing children who need so much. In a country stripped form war, disease, and starvation, your love and efforts will make such a difference! AND it is our prayer that it will also be a life changing experience for each one of you.

Buyamba is humbled by your initiative to partner together in blessing the children of God Cares School. Please communicate with your team regarding <u>important</u> instruction before partaking on this mission with us in order to ensure <u>safety</u> throughout your experience:

	I have read the Travel-Information Guide and I am aware of the need for travel insurance, shots, etc. Please return a signed copy to the Buyamba office.				
	Connect with us on Facebook or e-mail regarding your trip. We would love to share your team's experience!				
	Please communicate all trip plans and schedules with the Buyamba office. No follow-up private trips will be allowed unless cleared with the Buyamba office.				
	Appropriate dress is necessary in order to be respectful and set an example as guests of God Cares School and the country of Uganda. Please see attached <u>Mission Team Travel Information Guide</u> for what to wear for it is culturally important.				
	Do not make promises to students (i.e. 'I will bring you a gift the next time we meet', 'I will write you every day when I return home'). While intentions may be well meaning, Ugandans take your words as a promise.				
	Do not give students your camera or phone to go around and take pictures.				
	Personal belongings should be left in designated room by social worker or you may carry it with you at all times.				
	Inquire with the school office regarding students' needs and gifts. Please do not ask the students directly. All gifts should be given to student(s) in social workers office at their convenience.				
	Do not take students or school staff out of the classroom for personal communication regarding sponsorship or interest to sponsor. All information regarding sponsorship should be communicated with the social worker or Buyamba in the U.S. only.				
	Do not give any money to students \underline{or} their parents. All donations should be done through Buyamba only.				
	Do not trade e-mails, mailing addresses, Facebook usernames, or any personal contact information with God Cares staff or students. The use of social media is against school policy due to accessibility and lack of money. All personal information should be communicated through the social worker only.				
	Buyamba is the sole U.S. operational fundraising organization for the God Cares Schools and the Dongo Family in Kampala, Uganda.

Please read and have all the team members initial the following: TEAM PHILOSOPHY

WE SERVE TO:

- ❖ Glorify God, to bring about His Kingdom, here, now
- ❖ Be a witness for Christ; therefore, we must know Him and be ready and willing to share the gospel
- ❖ Be a Christian witness in all we do. Others should see Christ in us despite cultural differences. This may mean we adjust so they can see Him − our freedom cannot cause another to stumble or to reject the message because of the messenger. (For example, we ask that you do not consume alcohol during mission trips to Uganda, even outside the school grounds. According to the Dongo family, the children have seen this usage as they pass by the locations where it is being consumed, thus sending a wrong message to the children).
- * Present a Christ centered worldview based on scripture. If asked, we will not present a non-Christian worldview, even if that is your personal belief
- ❖ Love the children and young adults of the God Cares Schools and the people of Uganda we come in contact with − they must be treated with the utmost respect. While socializing with team members is good and appropriate, when the object of our love is present, love them first
- * Be open to every situation that God places us in, from the airport going until we return home again because he has uniquely called us to this ministry trip.

Please read and initial the following:

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Short-term mission trips can be extremely strenuous & stressful. They may include long air/train/bus rides of 10-24 hours in duration. Participants are required to carry their own luggage. Restrooms are not always readily accessible. The housing/meeting rooms may not have air conditioning & may not have adequate heating. There can be a considerable amount of walking between the housing & meeting locations in addition to climbing many flights of stairs. The summer months in much of the world are very hot/humid & this might affect your overall strength/energy. The air quality is poor in many locations. All of these factors may aggravate certain health conditions & medical facilities in most countries where we travel may not provide adequate care. A medical statement from your doctor may be requested.
